CONDITIONS:

- **ALL Gear will be as per the current PCA National Gear Rules (effective 12th June 2023)**
- **ALL Events will be run as per the current PCQ Rule Book**
- PCA rider and horse age regulations apply
- Horses must be fit for riding, wormed and in good health
- Riders are to remain in their group, unless judges agree to a change for rider safety
- Spectators will not be allowed in the competition arenas (except 10years and younger age groups)
- No alcohol to be consumed on the grounds
- No smoking is permitted on the grounds
- Mobile Phones NOT to be used while on horseback
- Excessive use of whips or spurs will result in the rider being disqualified
- Inappropriate language or abusive behaviour will result in disqualification at the judges' discretion
- Horses must be ridden at a walk when not competing
- Dogs are **not** permitted in the competition areas and **must be on a leash at all times** in the carpark
- No refund after competition commences
- Judges' decision is final
- All disputes are to be reported to the Technical Delegate and must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the event (accompanied by \$50, which is non-refundable if protest is lost)
- The Committee reserves the right to alter groups or events if necessary

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS:

- The organisers reserve the right to:
- a) cancel any class or event
 - b) divide any class
 - c) alter the advertised times
 - d) refuse entry, with or without stating the reason
 - e) transfer competitors between classes
 - f) combine classes if less than 3 competitors
